- On the recommendation of then in place Committee, followed by a vote of the Community the Expeditions 3 was purchased in Hawaii, shipped to Seattle and made ready for use as the Island's primary Passenger Vessel.
- On the recommendation and under the partial supervision of the then in place committee the Elsie M II's Deck was replaced and the engines were rebuilt among a variety of other key items.
- On the recommendation of the then in place Committee a resolution was adopted and approved by the Board requiring a Deckhand on all Elsie M II runs.
- A new Vessel Committee Chairman/Board Liaison was named by the Board President.
- A new Vessel Committee was formed.
