

FERRY RULES

1. The captain has final authority to determine what cargo can be carried on the vessel.
2. The captain has the final authority to determine if the weather is safe for running the Holiday.
3. No building materials may be carried on the Holiday except (in certain circumstances those for Community maintenance work.)
4. No flammable materials on the Holiday, including lawn mowers and gas cans.
5. There is no smoking allowed anywhere on the Holiday.
6. Guests may not bring animals to the island.
7. Large dogs (must be leashed) on upper deck or the fantail only. The owner must remain with their respective pets) at all times.
8. All pets are the sole responsibility of the property owner. Owner of animal deemed to be dangerous or a nuisance will be warned ONCE only.
9. All animals to be leashed and restrained (or within a pet carrier) at all times.
10. Any owner who does not clean up after his or her pet will be warned once and may be denied boarding privileges.
11. Certain cargoes such as bicycles are on a space-available basis. A round trip may not be guaranteed for all items for all trips.
12. If an item is too large for one person to carry it is too large to ride on the Holiday.
13. Property owners are responsible for their guests being properly informed about Hat Island and Holiday rules.

Some cargo will be allowed on the Wednesday Ferry run only, for the support and convenience of island families.

The Ferry Captain's decision on ship's safety, volume or excessive quantity or weight of items brought on board prevails.

STANDING ORDERS

No Building materials.

No Propane or other fuels.

No ladders or contractor's equipment.

No Gas or gas operated tools. No automotive batteries.

No furniture.

ALLOWABLE ITEMS:

Food and beverages (no fee) Luggage (no fee)

Home Decor Items (Pictures, mirrors, drapery rods, etc.) Paint and painting supplies (1 gallon Max)

Small plants (Limit: 1 flat or 1 one gallon pot per person)

Planter pots

Potting Soil (2 one square foot bags limit)

Small automotive parts and supplies (1 tire limit only if emergency)

Golf Clubs (no fee)

Clothing (no fee)

Bedspreads, blankets, pillows Lamps and shades Kitchenware (no furniture)

Garden hand tools only

NOTE: Larger items should be scheduled for an "Elsie" run.
