NOTICE TO WATER SYSTEM USERS

LEAD AND COPPER MONITORING AND REPORTING VIOLATION FOR:

Dear Hat Island Community Water Users:

We are required to monitor your drinking water for specific contaminants on a regular basis. Results of regular monitoring are an indicator of whether or not your drinking water meets health standards. During 2016, we did not conduct our required testing for lead and copper by the December 31, 2016 deadline. Instead our past water operator took samples on January 5th, 2017. While we cannot be sure of the quality of your drinking water during that time, the January 5th test for lead and copper met DOH/State Standards. We have no records of any tests for lead or copper that did not meet DOH/State Standards for Hat Island. We are posting this notice along with our test results on the Community Website www.hatisland.org under the Water Tab. This notice will be mailed to all owners who have water connections along with their next water billing scheduled for November 2017. We can assure you that these requirements will be met in a timelier manner in the future and apologize for the oversight.

At this time:

- **No action is required by our water users.**
- **Our required lead and copper samples have been collected and meet State standards.**
- **All samples will be collected in the future by required deadlines.**
