HIC Board Meeting Minutes

Call to Order: The regular monthly meeting was held on Saturday, July 9th, 2005 at the Hat Island Community Picnic Area. Board President Stan Krohn called the meeting to order at 2:14 p.m. All Board members were present except George Alecci.

Minutes: A motion was made and carried to accept the minutes from the June meeting as printed in the View Point.

Treasurer's report: Melody Smith presented the Treasurers report. The report was accepted as presented.

Golf: Larry Bender reported

started and is doing a good job.

Vessels: Ken Baxter will be looking into the cost to overhaul the engines in the Holiday. He also stated that we will be looking for a new skipper for the Holiday as Willie had given his notice.

Maintenance/Equipment: Stan reported for George Alecci that the brush cutter had been repaired and the road along the pond had been repaired from the electrical line work.

Marina: Charlotte Maulsby presented the cost estimate for the breakwater. This estimate is about \$750,000 to \$820,000 for that work. This, combined with the docks, estimated between \$300,000 and \$450,000, and permitting costs that could run about \$100,000, the community is looking at an overall project costs of \$1,150,000 to possibly as much as \$1,500,000 to replace the docks and build a bulkhead to protect those docks. The board is expecting the cost to be around \$1,400,000. The design of the bulkhead would allow for a dock that would accommodate a larger passenger ferry and a small amount of additional moorage. The board is looking for comments for and against this project.

Water: Melody Smith noted that the eel grass study had been misplaced, but was again moving through the approval process for the dredge and water discharge projects. She stated the standpipe at the top of the hill would be repaired the following week and that water usage over the 4th weekend was slightly less than the previous year

and water was is good supply between the wells and the RO system.

Old Business: Melody reported that of the approximately 920 fee paying lots on the island, 570 lots had paid the full \$199.85, 22.5 had paid ½ lots amounts and there were 6 partial payments on the Community half of the Division H access road project. The Division H ½ had paid in full except for the first 4 lots which had a partial payment made toward them, leaving less than \$10,000 uncollected on their ½ of the project cost.

New Business: Questions were raised about rules that apply to the Holiday as well as to rules about riding four wheelers. These rules are posted on the Hat Island web site as well as periodically printed in the View Point. The continued discussion of enforcement was again brought up and most agreed that telling someone (or their host/parent) that what they are doing is dangerous will most often cure the problem, but if it doesn't, please feel free to let the office know.

Announcements: Stan noted that four more junk vehicles were leaving the island on the 13th, the fiber optic digging and cable pulling was nearly completed and Izzy Hill

has been hired to be trained to replace Margit, who is leaving the Island staff soon.

Stan also announced that two board positions will be open for the September election. Melody Smith and George Alecci have both completed their three year terms, and while they are both eligible to run again, the community encourages other members to put their names in the hat.

A thank you goes out to Sandy Russo for organizing the 4th of July

parade. There was a challenge put out for next year that is to be a contest by division for the best entry into the parade.

The meeting was adjourned at 3:05 p.m.
