**Maintenance/Equipment:**

George Alecci noted all equipment is operational.

**Marina:** Charlotte Maulsby confirmed the beginning of construction of the Harbormaster office. Stan noted that in looking into costs to install Z-piling in the inside wall, finding that the cost was about \$990 per lineal foot most likely makes that prohibitive at this time.

**Water:** Melody Smith announced that the application for the discharge permit will be presented to the county on November 28<sup>th</sup>.

**Old Business:**

Stan confirmed that the access road permits will be presented to the county on November 28<sup>th</sup> along with the discharge permits. This was the first appointment available to all necessary parties. It is hoped that the work will be able to be started February 1<sup>st</sup>.

**New Business:** There was no new business.

**Announcements:** Stan noted that the Board officers and positions for the New Year will remain the same as last year. The schedule of events and ferry schedule for 2006 has been completed and will be published on line and in the View Point. The office is seeking a new bookkeeper as Izzy has left the island.

The meeting was adjourned at 2:58 p.m.

**PREPARE FOR A DISASTER**

Our thoughts and prayers go out to the victims of the devastating Hurricanes Katrina, Rita, and Wilma. One of the hardest parts of this profession is to sit back and watch the magnitude of need and not being there to help. As we progress through the rebuilding of these traumatized parts of our country, we must not lose sight of the need to continually educate ourselves on the possibility of a wide spread disaster happening right here at home. What was evident in the Gulf area was the fact that public assistance is sometimes days away. The emergency service network was overwhelmed, and response to individual needs is in most cases nonexistent. This underscores the need for every family to have an emergency preparedness plan in place. Our area still faces the possibility of large scale disasters

capable of crippling our communities. We have seen fires, floods, windstorms and earthquakes capable of inflicting severe interruption to our lifestyles. Unfortunately, most people have not made any advance preparation for taking care of themselves if a disaster strikes. We encourage you to take immediate steps to prepare a family disaster plan for both your Hat Island home as well as your mainland residence. Such a plan will assure better protection and more self-reliance in case of a major disaster. It will provide for adequate supply of food, water, clothing, medical supplies, equipment, and an evacuation plan if necessary. It will also inform each family member of their responsibilities in an emergency. Please help keep your family safe AND prepared.
